Learn about Lloyd's Disaster Risk Facility, an incubation project led by Lloyd's to reduce the insurance gap faced by many emerging economies.

Get updated on its collaboration with Guy Carpenter and the Met Office (the UK's National Meteorological Service) to develop an agricultural weather index for insurance in Southeast Asia, which will use prediction capability in meteorology, to enable governments and farmers to plan and mitigate against the impact of drought on rice crop yields and allow for the development and implementation of insurance schemes that could be used to reduce the socio-economic impact to rice farmers in affected areas.
